At our first *Sip and Learn Social* Taasogle Daryl Rowe will talk about the invaluable life lessons he acquired at Hampton Institute. He locates the founding of Hampton Institute within the history of Africans emerging out of the horrors of bondage in the midst of the Civil War. His argument is that as Hamptonians, we have an obligation to our ancestors and progeny to make the world better in our own interests and images.

Daryl is professor emeritus of psychology in the Graduate School of Education and Psychology at Pepperdine University. He holds a Ph.D. from Ohio State. He was the national chair of the African Psychology Institute, is exploring new territory by developing a curriculum for African Psychology. Given this expertise, he is often called upon to consult with local, state, and national agencies and organizations regarding issues of diversity.
